April is the month that we celebrate our senior pets here at Flanary Vet Clinic. Even though as animal lovers, we all get excited about any new baby, we also know the true joy and bond that we share with our older pets! Fancy is now 10 years old which makes her a senior citizen! As a veterinarian (as well as their mommy), I feel there are so many things we can do in veterinary medicine to keep our pets healthy and happier in their senior years so they can live a long life.

Testing is the way your veterinarian can look inside your pet's body and find problems.



Listed below are the senior tests and why they are important for your pet:

- General Health Profile (GHP) This panel identifies problems with the kidneys, liver, pancreas, and gall bladder. Levels with these organs can begin to elevate before the pet starts to show signs of illness. GHP also checks glucose levels to help detect diabetes and check several protein levels in the blood.
- <u>Complete Blood Count (CBC)</u> The CBC tests for anemia, infection, inflammation and overall health of the blood cells. It evaluates the number of each type of cells, such as white and red blood cells. It can also detect clotting disorders.
- <u>Electrocardiogram (EKG)</u> This test for the heart can detect abnormalities in the hearts pumping cycle. It can give more information than listening to the heart with a stethoscope.
- <u>Radiography</u> X-rays are an internal picture of your senior pet. This can check the size of the heart, see some bladder stones and check severity of arthritis or degenerating bones.
- <u>Thyroid Test</u> A thyroid test can be useful in diagnosing malfunctions of the thyroid gland. Hypothyroidism (too little thyroid hormone) is common in dogs; Hyperthyroidism (too much thyroid hormone) is common in cats.
- <u>Urinalysis</u> This assesses the health of the urinary system. It can help detect kidney problems, diabetes, and bladder stones or infections.



APPOINTMENTS- CURBSIDE & IN-CLINIC

We are happy to report that we are now booking Curbside & In-Clinic appointments!

Here's what you- as a client- need to know

When **CALLING** to schedule an appointment: *Please specify which type*you prefer- If no preference is made at that time then an appointment will be
made for whichever type -Curbside or In-Clinic- is available first.

Surgery, Dental Cleanings, Spa Day, Boarding, and Drop Off Appointments will be checked in CURBSIDE.

When using **PETDESK APP** to schedule appointments: Please put in the Note Section which type you prefer- If no preference is made at that time then an appointment will be made for whichever type -Curbside or In-Clinic- is available first.

ONLINE PAYMENT OPTIONS & FORMS: From our website, you can now pay your bill online, complete and turn in patient & client forms, and more!

Covid taught us several things in Veterinary Medicine- one of those things being that clients LOVE subside service! No more wrangling your 90lbs dog or your anxious cat out of your car into the clinic, waiting in the lobby with several other pets, going in and out of the exam rooms as we care for your pets needs, and then having to load them back up into the car. Curbside has made taking your pet to the vet so much easier by us coming to you! Many even take the opportunity to run some errands or get a coffee while their pet is with us. We are so glad that we are able to serve our clients in multiple ways that best suit them & their pets! With COVID-19 causing a major increase in pet ownership, & more restrictions on the veterinary service industry we are very thankful to our clients & patients who have stuck with us as we navigated the new normal for veterinary medicine. With COVID-19 it brought forth many useful tools like Telemedicine & Curbside Service that we will continue to incorporate into our new "normal"; as well as bring back the original way that many are more accustomed too. With that being said, we have limited space for in-clinic appointments- we only have 3 exam rooms at this current timeand will be scheduling appropriately to ensure that there is no unnecessary crowding in the lobby area. Curbside appointments will continue to operate as they have for the past 2 years- If no one comes to your vehicle to check you in within 5 minutes of your arrival, please call 270-898-9738 to check in with the receptionist. A technician will be out to you as soon as they can to discuss your pet & their current needs once you have been checked in. As always, during your curbside appointment please keep an eye on your phone for a call from the clinic for the Doctor to go over exam findings, results, medications, etc. If you need to run an errand while we are working with your pet, please let the technician or receptionist know.

In addition, I want to stress that the most important thing you can have done for your senior pet at the veterinarian is simply, an EXAM! I can find out so many things about your senior pet that you may not realize. Starting arthritis medication can help your pet play again and feel younger. Finding a tumor while it is small can allow me to remove it more easily. Treating dental disease can prevent heart issues. These are just a few things I can pick up on with just an

exam. I recommend twice yearly exams for senior pets. Pets age roughly 3 ½ years in just 6 months. So, bring your seniors in to see me and take advantage of the senior blood work special so we can keep them all healthy and with us for many years to come. The blood work allows us to get a full assessment of your pet's internal health.
