
April showers bring May flowers! It's truly a beautiful time of year but with all the beauty comes allergens. In fact, the #1 reason dogs come to vet clinics is for skin allergies. The #2 reason is ear infections which are commonly caused by allergies. The key to treating your

pet's allergies is to identify the source. This can be challenging in Western Kentucky but Dr. Flanary and the staff at FVC can work with you to solve the problem. There are many options available to help ease your pet's discomfort. The 3 main causes of allergies in our pets are food, fleas, and atopy.

- <u>Food-</u> Less than 10% of allergies are actually caused by food. These usually result in ear infections, facial itching, and irritation of the rear end.
 - Treatment Specialized diets. Grain-free diets ARE NOT the answer. Pets are allergic to the protein/meat source in foods
 NOT THE GRAIN! Don't believe the people at PetSmart or the commercials on T.V.
- <u>Fleas</u> The most common source of allergies in our pets. All it takes is 1 flea bite! Just like it only takes 1 peanut to have a severe allergic reaction!! When a flea bites your pet, it deposits a small amount of saliva onto the skin. Your pet can develop flea allergy dermatitis, FAD, which is a reaction to this saliva. The reaction causes severe itching, which is very uncomfortable for your pet.

Fortunately, today there have been new advances in flea control to prevent FAD. There are preventatives such as Credelio - which lasts for 30 days and Bravecto – which lasts for 90 days (Both Available at FVC) that kill fleas and control flea eggs, and flea larvae, and all stages of ticks.





Check with your vet to find the most effective treatment for your pet. Be cautious, as many pets have allergic reactions to over-the-counter flea products (ones you find at the farm store, pet store, or Walmart), and they can also make pets very sick. With the introduction of new flea control products, no dog or cat should be allowed to suffer from

Flea Allergy Dermatitis.

- Treatment Keeping all pets in the home on flea preventatives year-round and treating the home/yard.
- Atopy Atopy is essentially everything in the pet's environment such as mold, pollen, and dust. In western Kentucky and southern Illinois, mold is common and maybe your pet's allergy problem. In our area, this can be a yearlong allergy versus just a seasonal one.



 Treatment – Prescription medications such as antihistamines to alleviate the reaction to the allergen and secondary skin infection.

LEARN HOW TO TREAT & MANAGE YOUR PETS ALLERGIES

There are many products & "home remedies" out there that claim to help with your pets' allergies. Dr. Flanary has over 30 years of experience working with pets & their needs, and one of the myths of the past that we continue to hear today is that human over-the-counter allergy medications work the same on our pets as they do on us. This is NOT true. In recent studies, it has been proven that common human over-the-counter allergy medications have little impact on managing our pet's allergy levels. These medications affect your pet differently than you or I and are designed to target different allergy symptoms than your pet has. So, while it may help the sneezing & upper respiratory signs- it will do nothing for the itchy skin & ears.

NOW, WE HAVE BETTER OPTIONS THAT HELP!

APOQUEL

This medication made its debut in 2014 and has been a game-changer in managing dogs allergies. It is effective in 86% of dogs and starts working in as little as 4 hours. One of the main benefits of this medication is that it does not cause harmful side effects in your pet's body like steroids do! This medication is used twice daily for 2 weeks to bring your pet's allergy

level down to a manageable level, then isdecreased to once daily to maintain them.

ZENRELIA

Zenrelia is a newer allergy medication that helps control itching associated with allergies. It is a pill that is dosed once daily

and can be used in dogs 12 months or older. Zenrelia begins working within just a few hours of dosing to provide relief for your pets allergy

symptoms and does not require a loading dose like Apoquel does.



CYTOPOINT ALLERGY INJECTIONS

This allergy management option became available in 2016 and has helped countless dogs since. With a 92% success rate reported by pet owners, It has become a great option in the fight against allergies! In the past, the only option that used to be available to help with allergies was steroid injections- which we know in the present-day long-term use can cause damage to your pet's liver, and possibly lead to developing life-long health conditions such as Cushing's disease. With CYTOPOINT we now have the option of an allergy injection without the

adverse side effects of a steroid. How it works is it neutralizes the main proteins in your pet's cells that signal your dog to itch. The injection lasts from 4-8 weeks and starts working within 24 hours of the injection being given. So, if giving a pill isn't a great option for you or your pet, an injection once every 1 or 2 months is much more doable!

MEDICATED ALLERGY SHAMPOO/CONDITIONERS/TOPICALS

The majority of the time, our allergy-prone pets have secondary infections in their skin such as yeast or bacterial infections, and/or very dry, flakey, inflamed skin. When this happens, you must treat the secondary problem as well as the main issue (allergies) to get your pet the full relief it deserves. Having & using the right shampoo and conditioner for your pet's condition can make a major impact on how well it responds to treatment & how fast they can feel better. We have many options available that come with a money-back guarantee to help your pet have happy, healthy, and beautiful skin. We can also bathe your dog for you using the product Dr. Flanary personally recommends for your pet at our Spa Days!

OMEGA FATTY ACIDS

Lastly, one product that is recommended no matter the level of your pet's allergy status is Omega Fatty Acids. Anytime your pet is on an allergy medication it should always be taking an omega fatty acid. OFA's is an all-natural way that can help your pets decrease the level of inflammation in their skin, decrease shedding, and help promote a shiny coat.

No Show Policy

At Flanary Veterinary Clinic, we strive to provide the best possible care for your pets. To ensure that we can accommodate all our clients and their pets' needs, we have implemented a No-Show Policy effective May 1, 2025.

Policy Details:

- 1. **Definition of No Show**: A no-show occurs when a client fails to attend a scheduled appointment without prior notice.
- 2. **Cancellation Notice**: We kindly ask that you provide at least 24 hours' notice if you need to cancel or reschedule your appointment. This allows us to offer the time slot to another pet in need.
- 3. **Consequences of No Show**:
 - First No Show: A friendly reminder of our policy will be issued.
- Second No Show: A reminder that any future appointments will require deposits
- Third No Show: Future appointments will require prepayment of \$50.00 to be deducted from your appointment balance. If you do not show to this appointment the \$50.00 is non-refundable.
- 4. **Exceptions**: We understand that emergencies happen. If you have a legitimate reason for missing an appointment, please contact us as soon as possible to discuss it.

5. **Commitment to Care**: Our priority is providing care for all pets. This policy helps us manage our schedules effectively and ensure that every pet receives timely attention. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in this matter.
